### **ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION**

18. In all cases the registration of animals produced by Artificial Insemination shall be treated in the same manner as animals produced by natural service subject to the following conditions:-

- (a) Written notification for use of the bull in Artificial Insemination shall be made by the owner/s to the Management Committee and such application shall state whether or not semen sale is intended.
- (b) The Management Committee reserves the right to require any or all of the following:
  - i) a copy of the bull's DNA profile certificate. **Required for O/Seas animals.**
  - ii) certification that the bull is free from any known genetic disorders as and when it becomes appropriate.
  - iii) such scientific test, examinations and conditions as the Management Committee may from time to time require.
- (c) Approval for use of the bull in Artificial Insemination under Regulation 18(c) shall be given subject to the payment of such fees as the Committee may from time to time prescribe.
- (d) The Management Committee may at its discretion withdraw approval previously granted under Regulations 18(c) without assigning a reason.
- (e) The Management Committee may at its discretion withdraw approval previously granted under Regulations 18(b) without assigning a reason.
- (f) The application for registration of animals got by Artificial Insemination shall state in the appropriate place on the registration form that the animal was produced by Artificial Insemination and such information shall appear in the Herd Book denoted by the letters A.I.
- (g) There shall be no restriction on the number of animals produced by Artificial Insemination from any one sire.
- (h) The application for registration of animals produced by Artificial Insemination using semen from a bull not in the same ownership as the female shall be accompanied by a sire authorisation certificate signed by the owner of the bull from whom the semen was purchased or his authorised agent.
- (i) The owner/s of a bull approved under regulation 18(b) shall record with the Association the name/s of the person/s authorised to sign sire authorisation certificates in respect of the bull.
- (j) There shall be no more than four (4) registered owners at any one time of a bull approved for use under regulation 18(b).
- (k) The Management Committee may require a parentage determination on the basis of tests as in 18(b) to be performed on an animal produced by Artificial Insemination before acceptance of the registration.
